UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- (1) **Building Project Updates & Snapshot** –
 - a. Loon Lake, Chewelah, and Northport – Ongoing fixes at Chewelah – most recently the sink coming off the wall. At Northport Clifford is talking to a licensed and bonded person to finish up some items. We still have some Library Capital Improvement Program (LCIP) match available for that work. Loon Lake is mostly complete. Friends have been funding and working on landscaping, irrigation and electricity for irrigation.
 - b. Colville – No new updates.
 - c. Hunters –No new updates.

- (2) **Advocacy to the State Legislature** – Amanda is part of the Washington State Digital Equity Forum (DEF) that is submitting a grant for BEAD money for digital equity efforts. In addition, DEF completed a report for the state legislature regarding digital inequities.
- (3) **Capital Campaign/Legacy Project** – Waiting to hear about the \$35,000 Avista Grant. There is a T-Mobile grant they will apply for in the 4th quarter. Visitors to the Loon Lake library are seeing the engraved rocks and it is creating some interest.

- (5) **Policy/Procedure Review** –
 - a. Policy 0036 Meeting Room Use Policy Draft – Trustees discussed suggested edits and called for a vote.

We are trying to make sure the budget accurately reflects what we are spending in the correct categories. Trustees discussed the draft and their questions. We have reset the Director's Salary on the wage scale to be in the acceptable threshold to continue to be exempt.

- (2) **Director's Evaluation Timeline and Process** – Trustees reviewed the proposed timeline. Becca and Jennifer will work together to get the Management Team Survey out. Becca will send out the Trustee and Director portion.

Alexis and I assisted a patron with some printing: "Awsome, you guys rock, thanks so much!"

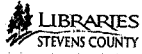
Patorn made a point to show me he was completeing a survey about the importance of library services from an elected official. :)
