She was excited because she didn't realize we had DVDs available for checkout. I ended up giving her a tour of the library, telling her about our Library of Things, puzzle swap, games for checkout, Mobius Passes, Discover Passes, Summer Reading and other programs, etc. She was very impressed and said she had no idea libraries had so much to offer now.

Recently a mother and daughter (4 yrs old) have been frequenting the library for 3-4 hours a day 3 days a week. Over many conversations we have learned that they are originally from Ecuador, and they are summering here. Since they are only here for a few months, they don't plan on setting up internet service or video streaming services. Plus they travel regularly, so they don't own games or puzzles. The mom was so appreciative that they could come to the library to read, play games, do puzzles, meet other community members, have playmates, attend programs, use the computer, have wifi access, ect. She said her daughter is learning to speak English, and she is surprised how quickly her daughter is picking it up. She believes it is because they have access to read so many books in English while they are here.
